Highlights



One MOU for all male & female players, renewed for 2022-23



Players continue to receive **27.5% of forecast ACR** (into the Player Payments Pool or PPP) with a Performance Pool (PP) of **2.5%**



Players continue to receive **27.5% of above forecast** revenue into an Adjustment Ledger



1% increase on all male & female retainers & match payments



Increase of WNCL matches from 8 to 12 (a full Home & Away season), providing up to \$7,000 in additional match fees



Any Adjustment Ledger generated from above forecast revenue (if available) to pass into player ACRA, player payments & programs

\$3.4 million to fund GamePlan Program & Player Development Managers (PDM)



Additional funding for PDMs to ensure gender equitable rates of pay between male/female PDMs



Australian PDM funding included for the first time

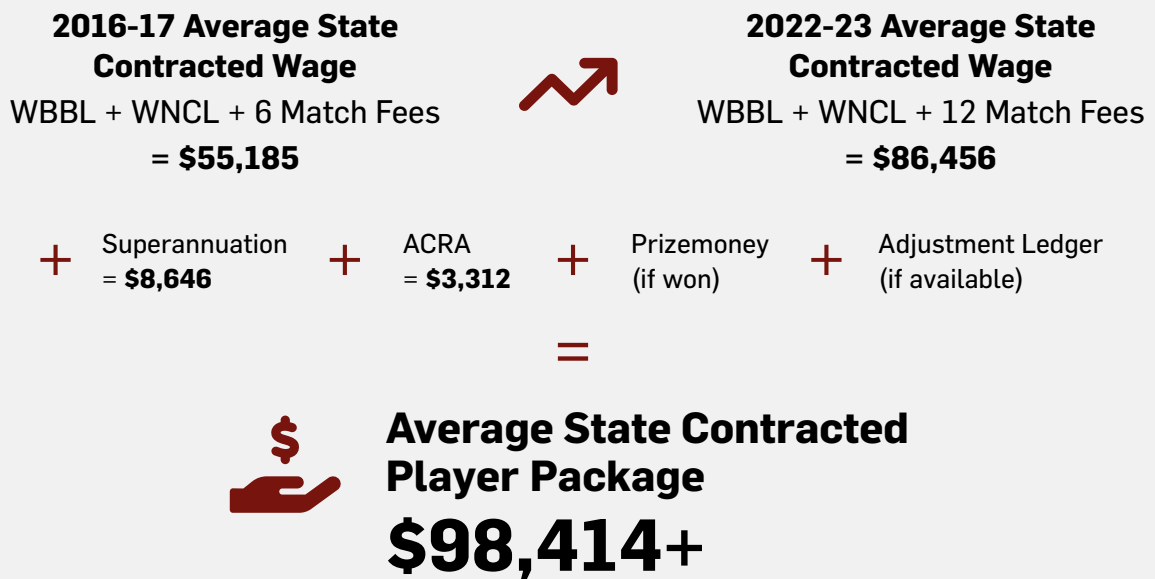

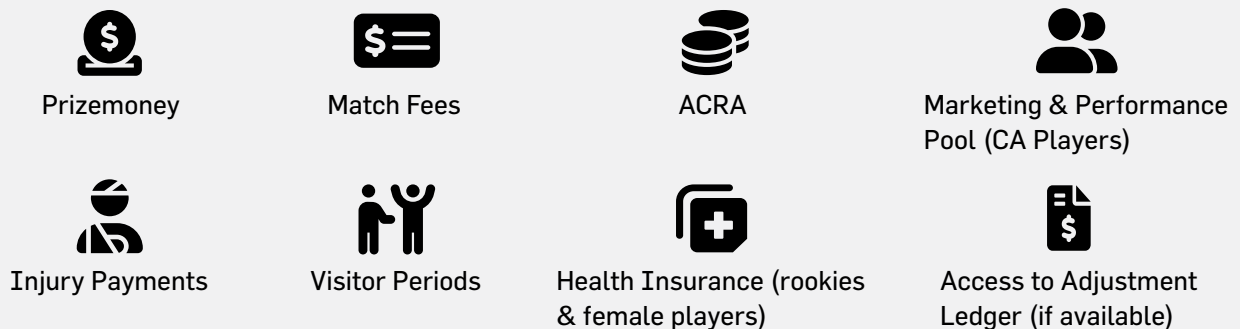
